

## ***SAFETY REGS for Steel Shoots***

1. EYE AND EAR PROTECTION AT ALL TIMES FOR EVERYONE
2. EVERYONE IS A SAFETY OFFICER
3. **DO NOT AT ANY TIME HANDLE YOUR WEAPON** WITH THE FOLLOWING EXCEPTIONS AND ALWAYS EXERCISING SAFETY WITH SPECIAL REGARD TO SAFE MUZZEL DIRECTION
  - a. WHEN FIRST PUTTING IN HOLSTER OR ON RIFLE RACK FROM RANGE BAG OR CARRING CASE
  - b. AT THE SAFE TABLE WITH **NO** LIVE AMMO PRESENT
  - c. WHEN MOVING TO OR FROM THE FIRING LINE WITH CARBINES
4. COLD RANGE – LOADED GUNS AT FIRING LINE ONLY - KEEP GUNS, AMMO AND MAGAZINE FREE UNTIL YOU GET THE RANGE COMAND TO “LOAD AND MAKE READY”
5. FINGER OFF THE TRIGER UNTIL YOU ARE AIMING DOWN RANGE
6. MAGAZINES CAN BE LOADED ANYTIME ANYWHERE EXCEPT SAFE TABLE
7. NO MAGNUM / HOT LOADS FOR PISTOLS OR RIFLES
8. SHOT OVER BERM EXCEPT A RICOCHET AND YOU ARE DONE FOR THE DAY
9. YOU MAY RELOAD ON THE LINE DURING AND OR BETWEEN STRINGS AT WILL UNLESS DIRECTED NOT TO DO SO
10. AT THE CONCLUSION OF EACH STAGE YOU WILL BE INSTRUCTED BY THE RO TO REMOVE THE MAGAZINE – SHOW CLEAR – HAMMER DOWN – HOLSTER WEAPON – FOR RIFLES REMOVE MAG, SHOW CLEAR AND LEAVE ACTIONS OPEN – YOU MAY THEN PROCEED TO YOUR STAGING AREA
11. RIFLES WHEN TRAVELING TO AND FROM THE FIRING LINE & WHEN STORED ON THE GUN RACK OR DESIGNATED TABLE ARE TO HAVE
  - a. EMPTY CHAMBER
  - b. ACTIONS OPEN
  - c. MAGS OUT
  - d. MUZZELS STRAIGHT UP WHILE CARRYING
